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TRANSDERMAL GEL DIRECTIONS

Your veterinarian has prescribed your medication in a transdermal gel. This form allows the medicines to be absorbed into the bloodstream through the layers of your skin. Please follow the directions below. If you have any questions, please contact our pharmacy.

- 1) Wear a finger cot when a caregiver is applying the transdermal gel.
- 2) Push the prescribed amount of medication out of the applicator onto your fingers.
- 3) Rub the medication well into the area indicated by your prescription.
- 4) Rub the gel in well (like you would with hand lotion).
- 5) Remove finger cot as needed, and wash hands thoroughly.
- 6) There may or may not be a thin film of powder left after the gel dries. This depends on the medication that is prescribed. If there is a thin film, it may be wiped off with a damp paper towel before the next application
- 7) There are _____doses per applicator.
- 8) Store the gel at room temperature
